



GENERAL SECRETARY – REPORT 2025

Report of the period between the 1st January 2025 and the 31st November 2025 of INTERRA activity

Brief report:

During this period, it was organized the INTERRA WORLD WINNER Show in Nitra. There was a high number of entries, 546 from all breeds, and the quality was very high. In December there will be the INTERRA EUROPEAN WINNER Show in Brussels, together with one of the national shows, and a good entry is expected as well.

We were contacted regarding the application of a new member and just waiting for the approval of their general meeting to close the process. The applicants from last year seemed to have lost interest in joining our organization.

The Facebook page was updated several times during this time, with INTERRA specialist judges updates, Terrier Shows schedules, results of Club shows, and links to our webpage (<http://interra-terrier.com>). The webpage was also updated with the relevant information regarding the Annual Meeting, reports and pictures from shows, and news about the Terrier club shows of our members. Once again we ask the INTERRA members to send the information on their activities, so we can promote them.

Our Treasurer, became seriously ill and hospitalized, so we had to get the help of Mr Bruno Carpaccio as Joint Treasurer to ensure that access to the Bank account will be possible. This matter is still in arrangements, also with the help of the Royal Belgium Terrier Club, due to the huge bureaucratic difficulties in Belgium.

We reinforce the appeal to our members that when changing the board of the Clubs, transmit the information about INTERRA, and let INTERRA know who are the new representatives of each Club are. As we stated in last year's reports, we may understand that changes can happen in the board of the different countries-associations and these changes are not reported to the Committee of INTERRA. Even not all the necessary information is given to their successors; the Committee of INTERRA tries to keep updated. So the board of INTERRA decided not to exclude the countries from the list, in order of accomplishing our terms of agreement with FCI, and also because we hope that some of them pay, as it has happened before.

Still INTERRA needs the collaboration of the member clubs. We received the programs for the Terrier National Speciality or even regional shows from very few of our members, and had put them on our webpage, other countries must send us the information regarding shows, results, working trials or seminars. It is our job to promote Terrier events organized by INTERRA members, but it is impossible to do so, if we are not told about them.
